

BEACH CLEANUPS

WHY WE DO BEACH CLEANUPS!

As all of us know in the past few decades we have depraved nature so badly. Nowadays whatever we are facing is just like the action reaction mechanisms of nature. Only humans are responsible for all kinds of pollution. Beaches need to be clean because whatever garbage dumping or any other plastic material which makes it dirty will get into the sea and it will affect the life of aquatic animals. It doesn't seem but have a moreover effect on them. Some of them unknowingly swallow such things which can take their life. Also beaches are sightseeing attractions for local tourists and foreign tourists too, if they are not cleaned up properly then it won't remain the same. So it is our responsibility to keep our beaches and surrounding clean.

WHAT DO WE DO!

'For Future India' started in January 2020 and till now we have cleaned beaches including Uttan Beach, Velankanni Beach, Gorai Beach, Manori Beach, Arnala Beach, Danapani Beach, Juhu Beach, and Khardanda Beach with 30000+ volunteers for 164+ times. And removed approx. 8,50,000+ kg of waste and plastic materials. Along with those cleanups we also save Mangroves. They perform important ecological functions like nutrient cycling, hydrological regime, coastal protection, fish-fauna production, etc.

WHAT WE WANT TO DO!

Our main target is to awake people about the side effects of plastic pollution in the sea and to protect the lives of aquatic animals. Instead of dumping plastic we must recycle and reuse it. Also, we want to increase the number of Mangroves to make beaches clean and blue.



MANGROVES CLEANUP & CONSERVATION

WHY WE DO MANGROVES CLEANUP!

Mangroves have been threatened by deforestation for decades, as agriculture and aquaculture, urban development and harvesting have caused the loss of more than a quarter of mangrove forests in the past 50 years. 62% of the lost area was due to human causes, mainly farming and aquaculture. Mangroves play important roles in preventing sea erosion and seawater intrusion, which softens the impact of tsunamis. They are also known as blue carbon sinks because they can transfer and store carbon in their sediments and within plant parts at rates far greater than those of terrestrial forests. Local action, such as routine mangrove cleaning up is urgently needed to prevent plastic from destroying mangrove forests and their ecosystem.

WHAT DO WE DO!

We started mangroves Cleanup Drive along with Maharashtra Forest Department, Mangroves Foundation on July 2021. We have obtained many benefits from planting/growing Mangroves in our city. We undertook the task of informing the people about the benefits and importance of the Mangroves bordering the sea. Many college and school students, as well as locals from the city, took part in the campaign. From last one and half year, we started mangroves forest cleaning campaign at Bhayander East and West and have managed to remove more than 100+ tons of garbage from this place. This campaign will continue with great success.

WHAT WE WANT TO DO!

It is very important to protect the Mangrove forest and to spread the message to the people about how important the Mangrove forest is for each of us. It is necessary to spread awareness among the locals by implementing Mangroves cleaning campaigns. Cleaning of Mangrove forest as well as replanting of Mangrove forest with the help of locals & administration in the place from which Mangrove forest has been destroyed. To inform every citizen about the importance of Mangrove forests for the present and future in terms of environment and society.





INTERCOLLEGE COMPETITION

19TH NOVEMBER 2022 TO 12TH MARCH 2023
(4 MONTH DURATION OF PREMIER LEAGUE & AROUND 32 CLEANUP
CONDUCT IN COMPETITION)

CPL as an inter-college competition can be a medium to create awareness about cleanliness and plastic freedom n society through youth participation. Our sincere effort in the competition will help connect the youth with the Swachh Bharat concept. The competition is being organized by For Future India to combat the problem of ocean pollution and the increasing amount of plastic in marine waste. We believe that this competition will create massive awareness and massive behavioural change about how the use of plastic is harming our marine life.

About the Competition:

Any college can participate in this CPL inter-college competition. Since the number of competing teams is fixed, first valid registrations will be considered. It shall be mandatory for the competing team to provide correct information about the college and volunteers in the registration. The college will be expected to appoint a team captain who will do the coordination properly. It should be noted that no registration fee or other charges will be charged in CPL Intercollege Competition. This competition is organized for 4 months from 19th November 2022 To 12th March 2023. A total of 32 cleanliness drives will be conducted in which the team will be required to participate in 1 beach and 1 mangrove cleanup drive (the teams can only participate in 8 cleanup drives). Beach cleaning campaign implement at 1. Uttan Beach, Bhayandar 2. Velankanni Beach, Bhayandar 3. Gorai Beach, Borivali 4. Manori, Beach Malad. Mangrove Cleanup is to be implemented in coastal areas at 1. Bhayandar East Khadi 2. Bhayandar West Khadi 3. Gorai Creek at Borivali West 4. Malad, Manori. In the competition, the number of volunteers present in the team and the total cleanliness drive will be the winning team competition (1st, 2nd, 3rd).

Rules & Regulations

- 1. It will be mandatory for the team to register with proper information.
- 2. This competition is organized for 4 months. It will be mandatory for the team to participate in 1 beach and 1 Mangroves cleaning drive in each of the 4 months. (Can participate in only 8 cleanliness drives)
- 3. Apart from the registered volunteers, the team may involve other volunteers in the cleanliness drive keeping in mind the issue of public awareness. The number will be calculated by taking into account the external volunteers.
- **4.** It will be mandatory to submit an attendance form and photo along with the college banner after each cleanliness drive. E-Certificate will be issued to the volunteers of each Cleanup drive after receiving the Attendance form.
- 5. The schedule of the cleanliness drive will be announced before the start of the competition, CPL Management will have the decision to change the schedule and select a cleaning campaign
- **6.** Each team will be given the materials required for the cleanliness drive by the management. This will include gloves, a first aid kit, buckets and other cleanup tools. Gumboots will be provided for mangrove cleanup. (Note: Gumboot stocks are limited so first come first served.)
- 7. Volunteers in the cleanliness drive should wear comfortable clothes and carry their drinking water bottles. Please note that the travel expenses will not be paid by the management.
- 8. Decisions of the Management Team shall be final and binding on all Teams.

- 1. The team will be awarded a trophy and cash prize of Rs. 20,000 as the first winning team of the tournament.
- 2. Momentos and certificate for the captain of the team
- 3. Medal and certificate to each volunteer in the team

- 1. The team will be awarded a trophy and cash prize of Rs. 15,000 as the second winning team of the tournament.
- 2. Momentos and certificate for the captain of the team
- 3. Medal and certificate to each volunteer in the team

THIRD WINNING TEAM

- 1. The team will be awarded a trophy and cash prize of Rs. 10,000 as the third winning team of the tournament.


